**RESOLUTION TO RATIFY CLOSING FERGUSON TOWERS TO THE PUBLIC DUE  
TO COVID-19**

**WHEREAS**, the Housing Authority of the City of Linden (“Housing Authority”), a public entity organized and existing pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”), and the laws of the State of New Jersey, determined that it was in need of addressing an urgent situation caused by COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, specifically, in order to control the spread of COVID-19 and thereby protect the health and safety of its residents and employees, the Housing Authority determined that it was necessary to close Ferguson Towers to the public on a temporary basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has found that it is in the best interest of the Housing Authority and its overall goal of providing quality affordable housing to low-income seniors to ratify closing Ferguson Towers to the public due to COVID-19;

**NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Linden hereby ratifies closing Ferguson Towers to the public due to COVID-19; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby directs the Executive Director of the Housing Authority to take any and all necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
