WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has found that it is in the best interest of the Housing Authority and its overall goal of providing quality affordable housing to low-income seniors to name George G. Woody Jr. as the Authority's 2021 Black History Man of the Year and to present him with a trophy;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Linden hereby names George G. Woody Jr. as the Authority's 2021 Black History Man of the Year and presents him with a trophy; and
